Voyage of Discovery is designed for ambitious and innovative UAE university graduates, who are keen to develop a deeper understanding of the shipping and port industries. The aim of the programme is to give graduates the chance to develop the required knowledge and demonstrate competency in their field, to be considered for future job roles and fulfil a sustainable career with AD Ports Group.



The development programme offers recent university graduates with a minimum GPA of 3 and IELTS 6, a once in a lifetime opportunity to be fully supported in their transition from academia into the business environment. It provides a chance to define their career path and gain specific tools and skills that are needed to succeed in their chosen profession.
